### **Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) Policy Advisory Council (PAC) 01-11**

The Coast Guard announces the release of and seeks comments on Policy Advisory Council (PAC) Decision 01-11, "Voluntary Use of TWIC Readers." This PAC Decision provides guidance for using Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) readers as part of a Vessel Security Plan (VSP) or Facility Security Plan (FSP). This PAC Decision is directed at owners and operators of vessels and facilities regulated under the Maritime Transportation Security Act (MTSA), for the purpose of purchasing and installing TWIC readers and systems.
