Effectively immediately, U.S. Customs & Border Protection has expanded services and opened an Operations Center at 139 Southern Boulevard, Savannah, Georgia 31405. This facility is staffed 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The following functions will be handled at the Operations Center:

- Reporting of aircraft arrival/changes: 24 hour number 912-232-7507 or 912-721-4900.
- Submission of crew/passenger lists: 912-721-4848 fax
- Reporting of pleasure boat arrival: 24 hour number 912-232-7507 or 912-721-4900.
- Reporting of Commercial Vessel arrival/changes: 24 hour number 912-232-7507 or 912-721-4900.
- Vessel Entrance & Clearances: for appointments call 912-721-4840 option 5.
- Export/outbound processing: 912-721-4840 option 3.
- Vehicle title processing: 912-721-4840 option 3.
- Submission of vehicle titles

- Status of releases (after the required 48 hour wait period): 912-721-4840 option 7.
- Registration of personal articles prior to going abroad: for appointments call 912-721-4840 option 5.
- Validations of in bond documents: walk-in service from 8:00a.m. to 5:00p.m.
- Submissions of manifest documents

Any documents being sent via U.S. Postal or overnight courier related to any of the areas noted above can be sent to U.S. Customs & Border Protection, 139 Southern Boulevard, Savannah, Georgia 31405.

All processing of entry documents, collection of duties, and other entry related functions would continue to be processed at the U.S. Customhouse at 1 East Bay Street, Savannah, Georgia 31401. The Entry Unit can be reached at 912-447-9410.

Additionally, validations of inbond documents can be processed at Warehouse 27, Georgia Port Authority, Garden City as well as the Operations Center.
